I. Ask Waterband:

Ryan: Waterband has been rehearsing a lot these days. What is the band working on?

We've been hard at work tightening up our set. We're focusing on basic things like singing harmonies, discussing feels, adjusting parts to fit better, fixing mistakes, etc. Waterband has also been spending a great deal of time preparing for upcoming shows. It's really important to make travel arrangements, to know the other bands that will be at the show, to have a set list that is appropriate for the crowd we will be entertaining, etc. I think the better you know someone and understand their personality, the easier it is to work together. So, in addition to the hard work, it has been nice to take time to just "chill" and get to know each other better. Some valuable things that I've learned thus far at Waterband practice...

1. Peaches are better than cherries, unless you are going to eat the fruit, then cherries are better than peaches, make sure you always save one for your manager.
2. John is a magical person... it only takes him one strum to make a guitar go out of tune.
3. Habanero peppers are not hot until you swallow them, then they are HOT!!!

Taylor: Now that you've got your feet wet performing with Waterband at Waterband's Waterfest, Musica Concert Hall, Dugway Watershed Day and River Street Jazz Café, how have the Waterband Fans (the aquaholics) embraced you?

The Aquaholics are such an incredible group of fans. They have completely embraced me whole-

heartedly, as I have to them. Quite literally really, everyone gives hugs! I've met so many great people over the past couple months that it's hard to remember all of the names! I'll always remember a face though (And all of you Aquaholics have beautiful faces). I think it's so cool that we can post a bulletin online announcing that we will be playing a show in just a few hours and have a good amount of people show up. I've heard so much about how happy everyone is to see me in the band, and it really means a lot to me. So, thank you Aquaholics, you're all so amazing!!! I'll see you at the next show!

John: Waterband has started performing select shows acoustically. Tell us more.

We have recently discovered that "unplugging" has allowed us to focus on things like dynamics, harmonies, and just over-all communication with each other. Getting "Down to the roots" one might say. It has helped us quite a bit as we are really starting to gel with the new line-up. It is truly helping us a lot and it is a pleasure making music with Ryan, Taylor, and Dreadlock Dave both acoustically and as a full blown electric aural assault! Come check us out! We hope you will see the recent improvements!

David: Tell us about the "War No More" video.

The suggestion for the video was brought up by our videographer David Sullivan of Terrapin Media. (www.terrapinmedia.net)

He found out about a video contest sponsored by Peace One Day (peaceoneday.org) in which you could submit "your take on peace" in a two minute video. David's suggestion turned into a last minute effort to gather any and all fans, friends & families in Kent, Ohio on a Sunday to film an improvised video for "War No More". We recorded a special acoustic two minute version of the song in order to meet the video contest requirements which was edited in after the filming... we lip synced better than Milli Vanilli!
